

The Lee Scholarship Fund

Leighton II and Marietta F. Lee established an education fund to assist spouses and children of Lee Company employees who are currently pursuing or plan to pursue postsecondary education in undergraduate and vocational programs. The establishment of this fund builds upon the Lee family's strong belief in the value of education.

Eligibility: Children and spouses of full-time employees of The Lee Company who are currently enrolled or have applied for admission to a degree program of a postsecondary learning institution (accredited college or university) in a curriculum leading to a bachelor's or associate's degree. Complete details of eligibility criteria are available at www.cfgnh.org/scholarships.

Awards: The Education Subcommittee of The Community Foundation for Greater New Haven's Board of Directors selects recipients and determines the amount of each award. In no instance does any officer or employee of The Lee Company play a part in the selection process. The amount of any award is based on available resources, academic achievement and financial need. Scholarship recipients must re-apply each year for consideration for subsequent awards.

Application: Interested applicants must complete the online application form and mail in the following materials: their academic transcript, two letters of recommendation, Student Aid Report from FAFSA and their parents' income tax return. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied, therefore, it is important to answer all questions as completely as possible and to provide all requested documents. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by The Community Foundation and its designees.

Selection of Recipients: Recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, potential to succeed, leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, statement of education and career goals and letters of recommendation. Once recipients have been selected, financial need is assessed to determine the amount of each award. Applicants will be notified by email of whether or not they have been awarded a scholarship.

Payment: Scholarship checks will be processed and mailed directly by The Community Foundation to the recipients' schools.

Obligations: Recipients must supply The Community Foundation with enrollment verification from a postsecondary learning institution (accredited college or university) and a completed scholarship remittance form. Recipients must also notify The Community Foundation of any changes in address, school enrollment or other relevant information.
