

The H. Pearce Family Scholarship Fund

The H. Pearce Family Scholarship Fund was established to assist employees and families of the H. Pearce Real Estate Company, the New Haven Symphony Orchestra and the Long Wharf Theatre who are currently pursuing or plan to pursue postsecondary education in undergraduate and vocational programs.

Eligibility: Full-time employees, independent contractors and spouses and children of full-time employees and independent contractors of the H. Pearce Real Estate Company, the New Haven Symphony Orchestra and the Long Wharf Theatre. Complete details of eligibility criteria are available at www.cfgnh.org/scholarships.

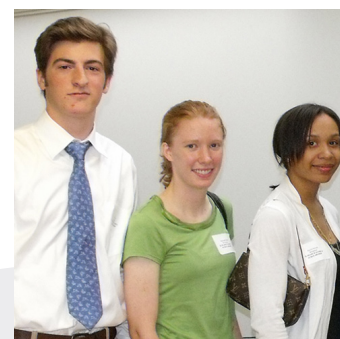
Awards: The Education Subcommittee of The Community Foundation for Greater New Haven's Board of Directors selects recipients and determines the amount of each award. In no instance does any officer of the H. Pearce Real Estate Company, the New Haven Symphony Orchestra or the Long Wharf Theatre play a part in the selection process. The amount of any award is based on available resources, academic achievement and financial need. Scholarship recipients must re-apply each year for consideration for subsequent awards.

Application: Interested applicants must complete the online application form and mail in the following materials: their academic transcript, two letters of recommendation, Student Aid Report from FAFSA and their parents' income tax return. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied, therefore, it is important to answer all questions as completely as possible and to provide all requested documents. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by The Community Foundation and its designees.

Selection of Recipients: Recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, potential to succeed, leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, statement of education and career goals and letters of recommendation. Once recipients have been selected, financial need is assessed to determine the amount of each award. Applicants will be notified by email of whether or not they have been awarded a scholarship.

Payment: Scholarship checks will be processed and mailed directly by The Community Foundation to the recipients' schools.

Obligations: Recipients must supply The Community Foundation with enrollment verification from a postsecondary learning institution (accredited college, university or technical school recognized as tax exempt) and a completed scholarship remittance form. Recipients must also notify The Community Foundation of any changes in address, school enrollment or other relevant information.
