DESIGNATED FUNDS
Grants from designated funds support specific organizations in perpetuity, as expressed by individual donors or groups.

DONOR ADVISED FUNDS
Grants from donor advised funds are made with the participation of the donors, who wish to be involved in their philanthropy on an ongoing basis.

FIDUCIARY FUNDS
Grants from fiduciary funds are made on behalf of an organization or project for which The Community Foundation serves as fiscal steward.

giveGreater.org®
Grants from giveGreater.org® are given to the organizations as determined by donors. Grants also include funds to create incentive for giving during community challenges.

ORGANIZATION FUNDS
Distributions from organization funds are dispersed to benefit the organization for which the fund was established.

PREFERENCE FUNDS
Grants from preference funds address a donor’s area of interest in the community. The Community Foundation’s Board determines the grants that will have the most impact and fulfill the donor’s intent.

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS
Grants from scholarship funds provide assistance to students for secondary and post-secondary education and training, and are made to the educational institution.

UNRESTRICTED FUNDS
Grants from unrestricted funds address a broad range of local opportunities and needs, including those of programs and organizations that sometimes cannot be anticipated at the time a gift is made. The Community Foundation’s Board makes grants that will have the most impact.
